





Long Term Revenue







Cost of Fuel Calculation



Fuel Costs: One way, Frankfurt to Reykjavik, full passenger load (777 300ER)

2.695 liters per passenger per 100 kilometers

Assuming 429 seats, 2.695 * 429 = 1156.155 liters per 100 km

Distance from Frankfurt to Reykjavik = 1,475.92 mi, or 2375.263 km

(2375.263 km / 100 km) * 1156.155 liters per 100 km = 27461.722 liters

Assuming fuel costs for Germany as of Oct 28, 2016, \$61.90 USD per barrel

One barrel = 159 liters, cost per liter = 61.9/159 = \$0.389 USD per liter

O.389 USD per liter * 27461.722 liters = **\$10,682.610 USD per trip**


Emirates Unit Cost CASK Analysis vs. LCCs & Legacies








Emirates Unit Cost CATK Analysis




Landing and Terminal Charge Comparison





