#### **Exchange Office Services:**

All exchange partners offer course registration assistance, transcripts, orientations, and paperwork necessary to obtain a student visa. Orientations are held for in-bound students in the fall. MBS will provide details to accepted students.

The International Society is highly recommended for all international students and offers the chance to join organized events and trips at a discounted rate.

Registration is £10.00 per person.

A student visa is required for stays in the EU exceeding 90 days. Students should apply for a Student Visitors Visa if they are a Visa National (required to get a visa for entry to the UK). If you are a not a Visa National you can enter as a Student Visitor without a visa. MBS has staff who can assist you with visa questions: <a href="mailto:iat@manchester.ac.uk">iat@manchester.ac.uk</a>.

All students must register with a doctor as soon as they arrive in Manchester. Exchange students are required to pay £35.00 to register with a Doctor and an additional £35.00 for each subsequent visit. It is recommended that Exchange Students arrange private Health Insurance for the duration of their stay in the UK.
