Areas of Study: Indicate your majors, option(s), minor(s) and concentration(s).

Transcript information: Enter your credits, GPA and class standing.

Financial Information: Indicate scholarships, awards, employment and your financial picture in short answer format.

Policy Exceptions: Indicate intent to enroll full time or participate in study abroad or an internship.

Current Activities and Applicable Employment

Experience: What participation in extracurricular/work/community activities have you had which emphasize your leadership experiences? Briefly discuss the importance of these experiences and how they have made you a better leader. Please limit your answer to 250 words or fewer.

Educational and Career Goals: Please explain your specific short term educational goals and your long-term career goals and interests. Expand upon any items that you checked in the preceding section Specific Scholarship Eligibility that are related to this response. Please limit this answer to 500 words or fewer.

Personal Essay: What have you done outside of the classroom to strengthen your leadership and involvement with the university/college community? Of these, which means the most to you? Please limit this short answer to 500 words or fewer.
