APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Hosted by the UW Foster School Undergraduate Diversity Services, the Summer Business Bridge (B²) Program is open to all incoming UW Freshmen who are interested in pursuing a business major. B² focuses its resources on serving the following underrepresented minority groups: African American, Hispanic/Latino, American Indian/Alaskan Native, Pacific Islander and Southeast Asian. Participants will be selected on the basis of their stated interest in exploring business as a major, academic performance, resume and essay. Participants will be limited to 25 students.

B² program costs are covered by the program, including tuition for the 5 credit writing course (BA490) valued at approx. \$1,882.64 per student (not including housing fees). B² students will be registered automatically in this mandatory B² academic course. B² students also agree to participate in daily sessions focused on exploration of a variety of business topics as well as college transition and professional development workshops. Standard program days and times are Monday - Friday, 9:00 am - 5:00 pm. In addition to your weekday activities there will be some evening and weekend activities scheduled during the program.

B2 ELIGIBILITY & PROCESS

 All B² applicants must have submitted their Autumn 2015 Enrollment Deposit to the University of Washington prior to submitting their application.

Applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Academic Performance
- Leadership experience & activities
- Quality of the personal statement

- 4. B2 Essay: all applicants are required to submit three required essays; 1 optional essay
- 5. **B² Housing Scholarships (Optional)**: All B² students are encouraged to live on campus in the UW Residence Hall. Housing Fees are the responsibility of each student. To be eligible to live in a UW Residence Hall during the program students are required to live in UW residence halls during the 2015-16 academic year. B² Students are encouraged to apply for a B² Housing Scholarship if the cost of on campus room & board will present a financial hardship. Completed applications must be POSTMARKED no later than June 1, 2015 to receive first consideration.
