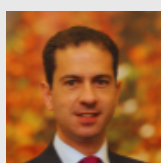




ABOUT THE SCHOOL

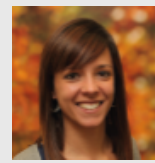

- Grading scale: 0-10 (5 passing grade)
