Overview:

Terms* & dates:

Students selecting Trimester 1 (July-Oct) will pay fall quarter tuition rates.

- Fall: Trimester 1 runs late July to late October (13 weeks)
- Winter: Does not align with UW academic terms.
- Summer: Does not align with UW academic terms.

*Note: Partner school terms shorter than 9 weeks during the Academic Year, and shorter than 4.5 weeks during Summer Quarter, do not qualify for federal Financial Aid.

Academics:

Exchange students take up to four full courses, equal to 156 contact hours per trimester. Banking and Finance, Strategy and Innovation, Marketing Management and Human Capital Management, as well as electives of the Nanyang MBA programme are available for selection. Students may transfer up to 16 UW credits toward their UW MBA degree. *Check with the UW MBA Program Office to determine your overseas course load.*

Housing:

Exchange Office Services:

All exchange partners offer course registration assistance, transcripts, orientations, and paperwork necessary to obtain a student visa. NTU provides student “buddies” and social activities to help exchange students get settled. NTU will provide details to accepted students.

A student visa and proof of adequate health insurance are required for study in Singapore. Detailed info about student visas will be provided upon acceptance to NTU.

Language courses:

No language courses are offered. All courses are taught in English.
