Our Fall and Spring terms are divided into two half terms (1st & 2nd). We offer exchange students the flexibility to choose either Half Term (8-week) or Full Term (16-week) exchange. Students will be eligible for course enrolment upon successful program egistration, and are required to arrive into Hong Kong before term commencement.



#### A. STUDENT VISA

Student visas will be required for all full-time and in-person incoming exchange students <u>without the right of</u> <u>abode in Hong Kong</u> (i.e. non-Hong Kong citizens). Please let us know in advance if your circumstance is different.

Students will need to courier the visa application materials to the MBA Office. It may take **up to 2 months** for visa approval by the HKSAR's Immigration Department. Upon approval, students will be notified to download the e-visa label.

Mainland Chinese students holding PRC passports will need an additional 2-4 weeks to apply for an EEP (往來港澳通行證) and relevant exit endorsement (赴港簽注) on their own after the visa label is approved.

#### **B. COMPULSORY HKUST TRAVEL INSURANCE**

The University policy stipulates that all postgraduate studies, including exchange-in students, are required to subscribe to the <u>HKUST Compulsory Travel Insurance Plan</u>, **on a compulsory basis**, at least one month before the commencement date of the exchange period.

Please check the <u>Application Form</u> and <u>Coverage</u> of the HKUST Compulsory Travel Insurance Plan. Your insurance coverage must include the whole study period.

#### C. OFF-CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

On-campus hall is not available for short-term exchange students due to the limited supply. Students are strongly recommended to pay a visit to the off-campus accommodation before signing a lease. A Housing Guide can be found at <a href="Off-Campus Housing">Off-Campus Housing</a>.

## **General Information**

Facilities and resources available for exchange students at HKUST

#### **A. DOWNTOWN CLASS VENUES**

- HKUST Business School Central Located in Central, Hong Kong Island.
- United Conference Centre (UCC) / General Chamber of Commerce (GCC) Located in Admiralty, on a need basis.
- No shuttle bus service is provided between Clear Water Bay Campus and downtown class venues.

#### **B. UNIVERSITY FACILITIES & SERVICES**

- Access to various student, sports, and recreational facilities on campus with an HKUST student card: MBA student lounge and breakout rooms, multi-purpose sports hall/gym, indoor and outdoor swimming pools, water sports center, tennis courts, soccer fields, culture hall and exhibition areas, common rooms, library, study rooms, computer labs, etc.
- Restaurants, cafes, banking services, a supermarket, a hair salon, HKUST shuttle buses to nearby subway stations, etc.
- Invitations to join seminars, workshops, talks, performances, and other events organized by the University, Business School, and MBA Office.



#### C. CAREER RESOURCES

In general, exchange students have access to the online job board and career resources like the Bloomberg Terminals. You will be invited to join certain corporate events run by the HKUST MBA Career & Professional Development Team. The HKUST Career Centre will also organize a range of career events throughout the year, including recruitment talks and Career Mosaic, which features local\*, regional, and international employers targeting HKUST Undergraduate and Postgraduate students, including MBA students.

\*Regarding eligibility for taking up an internship in Hong Kong, exchange students should refer to guidelines provided by the HK Immigration Department (Refer to Q23 on IMMD FAQ https://www.immd.gov.hk/eng/fag/imm-policy-study.html)

One-on-one coaching and career workshops are NOT available for exchange students. MBA exchange students will be considered as HKUST MBA alumni but do not have the university-level alumni status at HKUST.
