





TOTAL COST FOR 18-MONTH PROGRAM: \$99,935*

*Pending approval of Board of Regents.

The program fee covers:

- Meals before every class

ADMISSIONS EXAM

- We will accept expired scores when official documentation is provided.
- Application to TMMBA is test optional.
- For a candidate to be competitive without a test score, they must demonstrate quantitative readiness.
